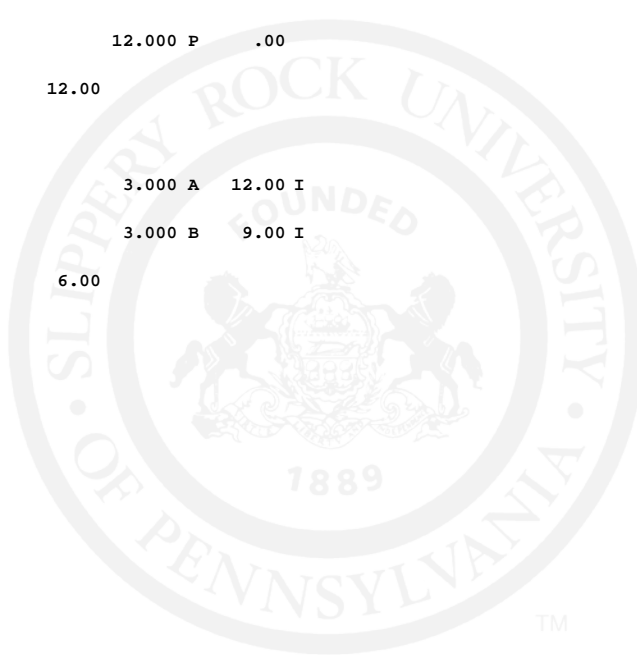

Transfer Credits

Grades and credit for work transferred from another institution are typically printed at the beginning of the transcript.
While transferred credits are usually counted toward graduation, transferred grades are not computed in the student's Slippery Rock University Grade Point Average unless they are taken as a "Visiting Student" at another Pennsylvania State System of Higher Education University and have either a grade starting with the letter "V" or a comment indicating the course was taken as a Visiting Student.

Grading System

Grade Point Averages (GPA) are computed by dividing the number of quality points (QPTS) by the number of GPA-HOURS.
Quality Points Per Semester Hour

A – Excellent	4.0
B – Good	3.0
C – Average	2.0
D – Passing	1.0
F – Failing	0

W – Withdrawn (not counted in GPA computation)
WL – Student withdrawn late from course (not counted in GPA computation)
WP – Withdrawn Passing (not counted in GPA computation)
WF – Withdrawn Failing (counts as "F" in GPA computation)

I or IN – Incomplete (Undergraduate Students)
Before June 1993 – changed to "F" if not completed by end of student's next semester of enrollment or remains indefinitely if student does not return to the University.
After June 1993 – changed to "F" if not completed within 12 months.

I or IN or IT – Incomplete (Graduate Students)
Before Aug. 2010 – With the exception of Thesis, if not completed within 12 months, the grade will convert to "W."
After Aug. 2010 – With the exception of Thesis, if not completed within 12 months, the grade will convert to an "F."

X – No grade given (changed to "F" if not completed by the end of the student's next semester of enrollment. If the student never enrolls again or graduates, an "X" may remain forever).
P – Pass (credit granted-not counted in GPA computation)
NC – No Credit (not counted in GPA computation)
AU – Audit (no credit – not counted in GPA computation)
T – Any passing grade transferred into Slippery Rock University that can be counted towards completion of the student's degree program will be preceded by a "T." For example, "TA".
V – Any grade transferred into Slippery Rock University by a Slippery Rock University student who has been a *Visiting Student* at another PASSHE university will be preceded by a "V" and will count in the SRU cumulative GPA. For example, "VC."
N – Any passing grade transferred into Slippery Rock University that is not being counted towards completion of the student's degree program will be preceded by a "N". For example, "ND".

Cumulative Grade Point Averages

The GPA's in the "TRANSCRIPT TOTALS" section at the end of the transcript represent:
INSTITUTION - Only SRU course credits and grades are included.
TRANSFER - Only credits and grades earned at other institutions are included.
OVERALL - A total of the SRU and transfer institutions' credits and grades.

Repeat of Courses

The course title and grade earned will be noted each time a course is taken. An "I" to the right of a repeated course means the grade was "Included" in the student's cumulative GPA, and an "E" means the course was "Excluded" from the cumulative GPA.

(Undergraduate Students)

Only the most recently completed grade earned is used in the student's cumulative GPA.

(Graduate Students)

If repeating a course before Fall 1991, the two grades are averaged. If repeating a course during or after Fall 1991, only the most recently completed grade earned is used in the student's cumulative GPA.

Academic Restart

Students granted an Academic Restart will have all grades awarded prior to the restart followed by the letter "R". For example, "AR". These credits/grades do not count in the student's GPA calculation or in meeting graduation requirements.

Deans List

- Published each fall and spring semester
- Student must earn at least 12 new semester hours with a semester GPA of at least 3.5 (starting Fall 2011).
- Student must attempt and earn at least 12 new semester hours with a semester GPA of at least 3.5 (prior to Fall 2011).
- Only undergraduates may be named to the Deans List. Post-Baccalaureate and graduate students are not eligible for the Deans List.

Honors Program

"Honors" courses are identified by either an abbreviation of or the word "Honors" in the course title. Students completing the requirements of Slippery Rock University's Honors Program will have this designation posted on of their transcript when they graduate.
